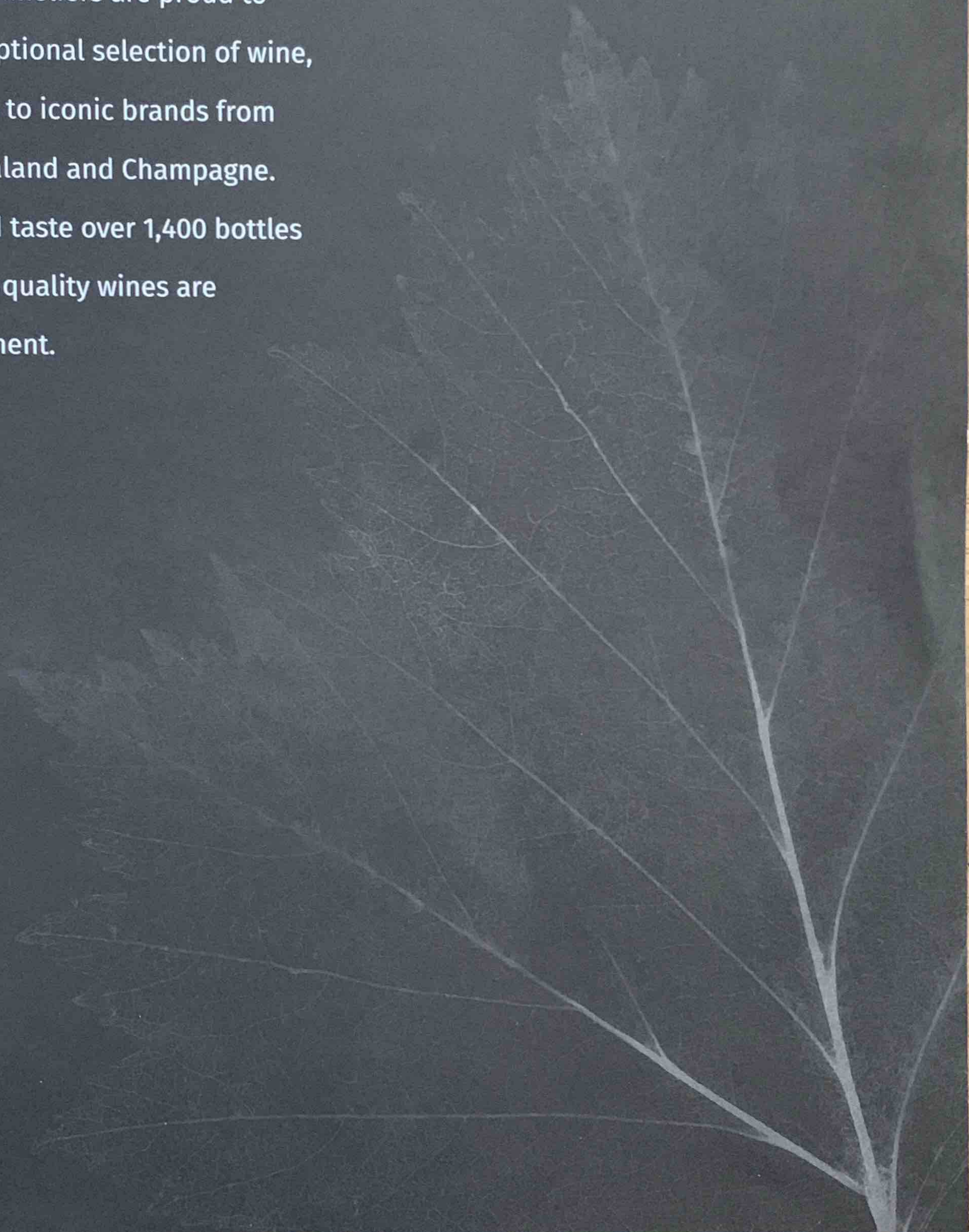

Champagne

Piper Heidsieck Rare Millesime 2002

Champagne, France

This, the prestige cuvee from Piper Heidsieck is a deeply intense wine with a flavour that lingers for many moments. The nose expresses its self with hazelnuts, white flowers and stone fruit while the palate fills with rich, but delicate flavours. It's the acidity that keeps this champagne fresh and leaves you needing more.

White

Mesh Eden Valley Riesling 2008

Eden Valley, South Australia

This wine is a collaborative effort from two of Australia's most talented winemakers, Jeffrey Grosset and Robert Hill Smith, using fruit from a region famous for producing world class Rieslings. It has long rich flavours of citrus and minerals with great persistence and texture, finishing crisp, clean and dry.

Henschke Coralinga sauvignon Blanc 2017

Adelaide Hills, South Australia

Henschke has long been peerless in the world of Australian wine. As one of the true founders of the Eden Valley, Henschke now builds on a nearly 200 year history in the Adelaide Hills. This lush, yet snappy Sauvignon Blanc showcases tropical fruit while the cool seaside climate of the Adelaide Hills provides a backbone of lively citrus fruit.

Flametree SRS Wallcliffe Chardonnay 2015

Margaret River, Western Australia

Flametree has caused quite a stir with this Chardonnay from the West. SRS (Sub Regional Series) is crafted from selected fruit that displays the best varietal character from the Walcliffe area which lies south of the Margaret River township. Terrific intensity and concentration of fresh grapefruit citrus, green apples and white stone fruits this wine has many layers of detail and complexity. Perfectly judged oak spices and fruit ripeness will allow for this wine to be enjoyed in its youth or for quite some time.

Red

Giant Steps Primavera Vineyard Pinot Noir 2016

Yarra Valley, Victoria

Winemaker Steve 'Flammo' Flamsteed was Gourmet Traveller Wine Magazines Winemaker of the Year in 2016 for good reason and it's his single vineyard wines which have forged his reputation. The Applejack vineyard is a slightly elevated, cooler pocket in the upper Yarra. The wine combined clever use of whole bunch pressing to create a complex Pinot. Dark red fruit characters, fennel and spice combine to create a very elegant Australian Pinot Noir.

Mayer Syrah 2015

Yarra Valley, Victoria

A small farm producing hand crafted, single vineyard wine, Timo Mayer believes that wines are made in the vineyard. Practising minimal intervention, the unfinned and unfiltered wines are a true expression of the terrior. Appearing dense maroon with purple hues, the nose is balanced with vibrant red fruits and subtle eucalyptus notes. The palate is more robust with hints of licorice and savoury tannins.

Woodlands 'Matthew' Cabernet Sauvignon 2014

Margaret River, Western Australia

Each year the Woodlands Cabernet Sauvignon is named after a different Watson family member. The wine is produced from the same vines that were planted over 50 years ago in Margaret River by the Watson family in 1973. This is an elegant, medium to full-bodied wine, with a lovely mix of blackcurrant, mulberry and dark cherry. The pallet has fine, tight tannins and structural finesse.

Dessert

Lillypilly Noble Blend 2015

Riverina, New South Wales

This is one stunningly aromatic dessert wine with tropical fruits and glorious fresh vital passionfruit, lychees and pineapple. This wine is a lighter style with lively acidity supporting the fruit characters. Sweet but balanced and seamless in delivery, it will leave you wanting more.
